The participant on this registration form has my permission to participate in the EPIC After School Program. I understand it is my student’s responsibility to inform me of the events in which he/she is participating. In the absence of a signature, payment of fees and/or participation in this program shall constitute acceptance of the conditions set forth in this agreement.

I hereby release EPIC After School Program (East Park Impact Center), its staff, volunteers and sponsors from any liability for any injury my son/daughter may sustain while participating in any EPIC event/transportation. In the event of an emergency, I hereby authorize one of the adult leaders from EPIC to serve as an agent for me, to consent to any x-ray exam, medical, dental or surgical diagnosis treatment and/or hospital care. Care must be provided by a physician, EMT, RN, surgeon, dentist (as appropriate) licensed to practice under the laws of the states where services are rendered, either at a doctor’s office or in any hospital or clinic. I expect to be contacted as soon as possible if my child becomes injured.

I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the EPIC After School Program (East Park Impact Center), East Park Church, employees, elected officials and volunteers while acting within the scope of their duties as such from and against all claims, demands, losses and liabilities of any kind and character, including cost of defense, arising out of, or in any way connected with the registrants participation in any EPIC activity or function.

EPIC After School Program is committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment. To promote safety and comfort for all, we ask individuals to act appropriately at all times when they are on site, at EPIC and/or participating in our programs.

PLEASE NOTE: Inappropriate behaviors will not be tolerated. This includes, but is not limited to:

1. Inappropriate attire is not permitted. Modesty is expected. Please refrain from wearing pants that are sagging and exposing underwear, clothing that is exposing too much skin (stomach, etc.) and clothing that is tight and seductive. School rules apply!!
2. Angry and/or vulgar language including swearing, name calling, racial remarks, shouting or harassment is not acceptable at any time.
3. Any demonstration of sexual contact (such as hand holding, snuggling, prolonged hugging) is not permitted. Guys and girls should abide by the six inch rule (stay at least six inches apart from the opposite gender).

4. Theft or behavior that results in destruction of property will not be tolerated. Liability includes, but is not limited to replacement of damaged property.
5. Carrying a concealed weapon (including knives) or devices/objects that may be used as weapons is never permitted. We have a ZERO tolerance to threats, harmful acts against others and weapons.
6. Carrying or using illegal chemicals, alcohol and drugs are not permitted. EPIC is a smoke free environment. Smoking is not permitted.
- 7. Loitering is not permitted on the EPIC site, grounds or parking lot. Individuals must attend regularly scheduled programs or leave the property.**

Do not hesitate to notify a staff member or volunteer if you have witnessed anyone that is not abiding by the code of conduct and/or if someone you know has been threatened or treated inappropriately. We are here to help!

I understand it is my responsibility and my student's responsibility to communicate effectively to each other regarding all transportation to and from EPIC. (Please see the EPIC Handbook for transportation options to EPIC after school.)

I understand that it is my responsibility to pick up my child from EPIC by 5:30pm closing each day. If I am not able, it is my responsibility to make other arrangements ahead of time and communicate the plans with my child and the EPIC staff.

Please allow my child _____ (name) to ride the Evergreen Public School bus from Hearthwood Elementary or Pacific Middle School to EPIC. (Bus #s and routes will be provided prior to the start of the program.)

Please allow my child _____ (name) to be transported in a vehicle operated by an EPIC staff person from Burton Elementary, Harmony Elementary or Cascade Middle School to EPIC. I understand the possibility of unforeseen hazards and know the inherent possibility of risk. I agree not to hold EPIC, its leaders, employees, and volunteer staff liable for damages, losses, or injuries incurred by my child.
